Schoenstatt's Founder, Father Joseph Kentenich, first crowned the Blessed Mother in October of 1939, because he anticipated World War II and the great tragedy that it would bring. In the concentration camp at Dachau, when starvation was rampant, he repeated this coronation, this time under the title "Bread Mother." He renewed this coronation repeatedly when

the circumstances of life were critical — always with success. Today we must turn to the Blessed Mother and crown her in order to acquire the necessary spiritual strength and courage to morally direct our world. Please invite family, friends, neighbors — all you know to join with us in **this coronation on July 4, 2012.**

Let's meditate on words from Fr. Kentenich: "Don't you think that our helplessness comes daily evermore to our awareness? I have no better response to our helplessness and misery than a continuous repetition of the coronation of our dear Blessed Mother... What do we want to express with this coronation? Our total dependence upon her and our attachment to her. Coronation is simply the expression of our very deep relationship to her, a continuous acknowledgement of her task in regard to our family, the entire world, and the Church; this is more clearly perceived by us the greater the helplessness of our situation" (1941).

Just the week before she sealed her Implantation in the Garden of Mary as the PATH in the historic garden of striving as she signed her blank check inscribing all of her past and future into the hands of the loving Father God and our MTA and Founder.

Growing up on a New Ulm farm with three brothers, her parents taught her to do most anything. Her mom was often quoted as saying: Be happy and cheerful and always keep the Lord in your heart. Verna has done just that in an outstanding way. Marrying and raising seven children she imparted the four pillars of our Schoenstatt Spirituality: divine providence, covenant piety, instrumentality, and everyday sanctity.

From her journal which she is very faithful in keeping, come many beautiful prayers which she shares with family and friends, and of course her Schoenstatt Mothers' Group which began three decades ago. "Life is precious and I turn to God always for guidance, to be where I need to be and do what I need to do to help." Verna can be heard musing: I like the thrill of not knowing; throwing myself head first into the deep end is my kind of fun. Her home shrine, **Great Mother and Queen of Harmony, Unity, and Peace**, was dedicated on October 16, 1988. It is the mecca of her apartment – which she keeps spotless and free of television and anything of the like. Our Lord and his Mother energize Verna. 
Three Covenant Dedications with our MTA
